Project objective: The MATERIALIZE Project — Methodology and Synthesis Advancement To Empower Researchers In Advanced optoelectronic materials — is a comprehensive, international postdoctoral program carried out at the Institute of Organic Chemistry of the Polish Academy of Sciences (ICHO PAN). Its main objective is to develop innovative synthesis methods and create advanced organic materials intended for use in technologies based on light interaction. The program aims to establish 15 three-year postdoctoral fellowships, which will serve as a platform for conducting independent research and building international career paths.

Total project cost: 19,679,390.00 PLN

Implementation period: May 1, 2026 – April 30, 2031
